

CAFERUIS - Certificate of Competence for Supervisory and Management Positions in a Social Intervention Unit

(French: Certificat d'Aptitude aux Fonctions d'Encadrement et de Responsable d'Unité d'Intervention Sociale)

Profession

The supervisors and managers of the social intervention unit are members of the management team. They occupy an institutional position between strategic management and work groups. They ensure the implementation of social or medico-social initiatives from the community values and the development projects of the institutions that employ them. Working under the institution head or a general management representative, they insure the accountability of a service or an institution with less than 50 employees, supervise a socio-educational staff and implement personalised projects for individuals.

Duration of training

From 18 to 20 months at a pace of one consolidation week per month.

In-class training

The training is divided into the following 4 areas of competence for a total of 430 hours at the training Centre:

- DC 1: Design and implementation of projects for a unit or service in the context of the institutional project = 120 hrs.
- DC 2: Technical expertise = 120 hrs.
- DC 3: Management and communication = 110 hrs.
- DC 4: Administrative and budget management = 80 hrs.

Hands-on training

Practical training comprises:

- 70 hours of hand-on training for the so-called decentring management function, either in-company or in the European context.
- 140 hours or 350 hours advanced hand-on training in the management function in a social or socio-medical service or institution.
